## 1. The Sustainability Coordinator shall:

- a. Serve a term of office from the first of May to the thirtieth day of the following April;
- b. Chair the Sustainability Committee and be responsible for administering the Green Investment Fund;
- c. Serve as a student representative on the University Environmental Issues Committee, if applicable;
- d. Maintain regular contact with the chair of the University Environmental Issues Committee, if applicable;
- e. Act as a liaison between environmentally geared clubs and societies:
- f. Provide guidance and support to all environmental clubs and societies,
- g. Report to the Vice President, External Affairs;
- h. Complete tasks as required by Council and the MASU and assigned by the Vice President, External Affairs;
- i. Act as a liaison between the MASU and the Sackville Youth Climate Change Coalition (SYCCC), if applicable;
- j. Not be an Officer of the Students' Administrative Council, as defined in Paragraph 12 of the General By-Laws;
- k. There is an honorarium with this position; and
- I. A final report is required to be submitted to the MASU.
