



The Student Board of Regents Representative shall:

1. carry out any duties which Council may assign;
2. serve a term from the first of June to the thirty-first of May as prescribed in the Mount Allison University Act;
3. be an informed advocate of student concerns and issues, in particular at the meetings of the Board of Regents, Council, and the MASU;
4. be responsible for accurate and regular communication of MASU policies and decisions to her/his constituents; facilitate the success of MASU operations and services through participation;
5. sit on a minimum of one standing committee of the MASU;
6. attend all meetings and forums of Council and the MASU;
7. attend all meetings of any committees on which they sit;
8. represent the educational, social, and personal concerns of Mount Allison students with an aim to improve student life;
9. chair the Student Board of Regents Committee and any other committee that may arise at the discretion of the Executive Committee;
10. serve as a student representative on any other Board of Regents committees that Council deems appropriate;
11. provide timely reports to Council and the MASU on the policies and decisions of the Board of Regents;
12. be responsible for accurate and regular communication of MASU policies and decisions to the Board of Regents; and
13. be aware of the specific issues which are of importance to students.
