



A Councillor-at-Large shall:

1. carry out any duties which Council may assign;
2. serve a term from the elected date until power of Council is handed to the Executive Committee for the summer months;
3. be an informed advocate of student concerns and issues, in particular at the meetings of Council and the MASU;
4. be responsible for accurate and regular communication of MASU policies and decisions to her/his constituents;
5. facilitate the success of MASU operations and services through participation;
6. sit on a minimum of two standing committees of the MASU;
7. attend all meetings and forums of Council and the MASU;
8. attend all meetings of standing committees on which they sit;
9. represent the educational, social, and personal concerns of Mount Allison students with an aim to improve student life;
10. regularly attend meetings of the constituency; and,
11. be aware of the specific issues which are of importance to students that may include but are not limited to: Facilities Management, Dining Services, Student Life, Municipal Government, Non-University Housing and Community Relations.
