



BYLAWS OF THE MOUNT ALLISON STUDENTS' UNION

Law IV

The **President** of the MASU, shall:

1. Act as the Chief Executive Officer of the Mount Allison Students' Union;
2. Serve a term of office from the first of May to the thirtieth day of the following April;
3. Serve as a student representative on the Security Matters Committee, Faculty Council, Board of Regents, New Brunswick Student Alliance, Senate, Canadian Alliance of Student Associations, and serve as a representative on other committees that may arise (e.g. University Presidential Search Committee) at the discretion of Council;
4. Chair the MASU Executive Committee and oversee the work of each Executive portfolio;
5. Act as the official representative of the MASU;
6. Represent the educational, social, and personal concerns of Mount Allison students with an aim to improve student life;
7. Be responsible for executive mandating based on consultation with the outgoing and current executive;
8. Be responsible for strategic planning and organizational vision; and
9. Perform such duties as may be required by the Executive Committee, SAC or the MASU.
10. Work a minimum of thirty-five office hours per week May to August, and fifteen hours per week September to April, as determined in conjunction with the Executive Committee prior to the beginning of the year.
11. Receive an honorarium; and
12. Submit a final report to Council.
