

CONSTITUTIONS

1. Constitutions provide both the MASU and the Club/Society Officers the terms and responsibilities of their affiliation. This includes:
 - a. The name and mandate, or objective, of the Club/Society;
 - b. Any fee, as well as the intended purpose of such a fee, that a Club/Society may levy;
 - c. The Executive structure of the Club/Society, outlining the members, and their responsibilities.
 - d. The contact details of the Officers named as Executives;
 - e. The terms of reference for legal liability;
 - f. The terms of reference for financial responsibility, including the naming of two (2) signing officers.

2. Constitutions submitted to the MASU by Clubs/Societies shall be on the form include in the appendix of this document.
