MOUNT ALLISON STUDENTS' UNION DONATES \$2,000 TO SACKVILLE MEMORIAL HOSPITAL FOUNDATION

Sackville, NB – The Mount Allison Students' Union has contributed \$2,000 towards the Sackville Memorial Hospital Foundation's "The More We See, The More We Can Help" campaign. The campaign, which has a goal of \$100,000, goes towards the purchase of a new portable ultrasound system, a special bathtub that enhances senior patients' comfort and safety, and two additional hospital beds.
