## Medical Benefits-at-a-Glance

Coverage	Up to a maximum of \$1,000,000 per student year for medically necessary treatment of covered illness or injury
	<b>Limitations</b>
	Reimbursement is 100%, up to benefit maximums.
Hospital Accommodation	Charges up to the ward rate or, where deemed medically necessary, an intensive or coronary care unit
Psychiatric Treatment	Treatment for psychiatric disorders, including inpatient and outpatient services, up to a maximum of \$25,000 per student year
Physician Charges	Medical treatment by a physician
Administration of Vaccines	Up to \$25 per student year for the cost of administering vaccines, antitoxins or injections (cost of drugs not included )
Annual Medical Exam	One annual medical examination and related laboratory tests per student year.
Diagnostic Services	Laboratory tests and x-rays when prescribed by a physician. Other diagnostic services such as MRI, CAT scans, biopsies must be pre-approved by Sun Life
Medical Supplies	Blood plasma, whole blood or oxygen
Maternity Benefit	Up to \$25,000 per student year for the reasonable and customary costs in the event of pregnancy or complications from pregnancy or childbirth (including caesarean section).
Well Baby Care	Expenses of well baby care and physicians' examination where deemed medically necessary
Emergency Treatment Outside New Brunswick	Up to the limit payable under the government health insurance plan for immediate treatment of an emergency while traveling outside New Brunswick. Up to 90 days covered for a stay outside New Brunswick and up to 30 days in your home country when the trip is not for academic purposes.
