Cole Cadorette Resigns as MASU VP Finance & Operations

SACKVILLE, NB — On Monday, February 26, 2018, the Students' Administrative Council (SAC) voted in unanimous favor to accept Cole Cadorette's formal resignation from his position as the Mount Allison Students' Union (MASU) Vice-President Finance & Operations (VPFO), effective immediately.

In his letter of resignation, Cadorette stated that the reason for his resignation is due to personal unforeseen reasons. Cadorette later stated that, "Even though I have resigned, I absolutely love the MASU and the work being done by the executive and staff. The MASU is an amazing organization full of wonderful people and I am so proud of the work I got to be a part of."

Cadorette was hired into the position of VP Finance & Operations during the hiring session in the spring of 2017 and began his role on May 1st, 2017. "We greatly appreciate the efforts Cole Cadorette has contributed to the MASU Executive team this year," stated MASU President Sara Camus. In the interim period, "The MASU Executive and SAC will determine a plan for the months of March and April. This will ensure that all responsibilities will be fulfilled until the next Vice President Finance & Operations starts their term in May," continued Camus. The MASU is currently finalizing their hiring for the incoming VPFO who would begin their term on May 1st.
